Word of God Academy was established in 2010. In 2018, WOGA graduated its first graduating class. The school’s commitment of Kingdom Education philosophy unites the home, church, and school for the purpose of scholastic and spiritual discipleship. WOGA serves the Shreveport and Bossier communities and has been accredited with Cognia since 2015 and ACSI since 2018. Upper School student’s schedule is to attend 36 weeks; two semester grading system; eight 90-minute class periods, four class periods alternate every other day. WOGA has grown from 22 students in 2010 to over 500 students in 2023. WOGA offers a full array of academics, athletic, and fine arts offerings.
