

WOGAHome On-Campus & Hybrid Costs and Fees 2024-2025

Lower School

Application Fee: \$150 (one-time fee)

Enrollment Fee: \$175

Activity/Additional Fees: Up to \$200

Tuition \$3,975

Notes:

A. WOGAHome for K-6th grade consists of at-home instruction by the parents. WOGA will not perform academic monitoring, but we will log and keep a record of course grades.

- **B.** The activity fee allows students to participate in school-wide events; class-level, academic field trips; the spirit shirt; and a WOGA water bottle.
- C. WOGAHome students may attend chapel.
- **D.** Tuition includes quarterly STAR testing and annual ACT Aspire testing. Students will need to complete these assessments at the Lower School campus.

Upper School On-Campus & Hybrid Fees

Application Fee: \$150 (one-time fee)

Enrollment Fee: \$200 (virtual courses only)

\$400 (traditional or hybrid courses)

Activity/Additional Fees:

Activity Fee only applies to students who are a Tier 1 status within WOGA Homeschool.

On-Campus Tuition Costs Per Course

^{*}Activity fee for grades $7^{th} - 8^{th}$ includes all field trips (minus missions' week), spirit shirt, retreat at beginning of school year, and quarterly events. Activity fee must be paid in full by July 1. Fee does not include extracurricular activities after school hours (ex. sports or clubs).

^{**}Activity fee for grades 9th – 12th includes all field trips (minus missions' week), spirit shirt, overnight retreat at beginning of school year, and quarterly events. Activity fee must be paid in full by July 1. Fee does not include extracurricular activities after school hours (ex. sports or clubs).

***Graduation fee includes Be There Night, Senior/Parent Breakfast during graduation week, gift at Baccalaureate, Cap and Gown, and after graduation event. Graduation fee must be paid in full by February 1.

^{****}Fee will include college guidance advising, transcript management, TOPS management, letters of recommendations, scholarship opportunities, endorsed WOGA Diploma, college planning meetings, standardized testing, and other items that involve graduation and parent meetings.

Middle School (Grades 7-8): \$500 per year, \$350 per semester High School (Grades 9-12): \$600 per year, \$400 per semester

Advanced Placement: \$750 per year, \$550 per semester (when applicable)

Virtual Tuition Costs Per Course

Course costs vary based on whether the course is taught by a WOGA teacher or through another virtual instructor. Virtual courses taught by the WOGA teacher will vary and will be made available prior to the start of the school year.

AP WOGA Instructed Course \$700 (full credit only)
Course Extension Fee \$200 per course

Additional Fees (Tier 2 students only)

College Advising: \$100 per session

Standardized Testing (Grades \$200 (includes administration of test and scoring) \$100 (includes administration of test and scoring)

PSAT (Grades 10-11): \$25 each Transcripts: \$200 yearly

Chapel: \$150 (Annual Registration)

WOGAHome Athlete Fee: \$300 for participation in first sport (Does not include specific sports fee

for equipment)

\$150 per sport for participation in additional sports

Payment of Tuition Costs and Fees

The application fee is due at time of application. Other fees are due with the executed enrollment contract. Tuition costs may be paid in full with the executed enrollment contract, or through equal payments online via FACTS Tuition Management. The use of FACTS incurs an annual Installment Plan Fee. Please note that FACTS payments made with a credit card incur a 2.75-3% fee. Final payments must be made prior to the student's course end date. Transcripts and diplomas will not be issued if an account balance is due. Tuition Assistance is not available for WOGA Homeschool identified courses. All payments are non-refundable.
